The Technician class license is the entry-level license of choice for most new ham radio operators. To earn the Technician license requires passing one examination totaling 35 questions on radio theory, regulations and operating practices.

### **Testing Process**

STEP :

You are required to Register with the FCC and create a FRN Number. Please go ahead and create a Username and Password The FCC will create your FRN Number in which you WILL NEED for the next step.

FCC Registration - Login

STEP 2

Using the FCC FRN system, you will log in and electronicly pay \$35 to the FCC

FCC FRN System

STEP 3

In Section 1 of the above 605 Application, there is a "Basic Qualification Question" asking if you have been convicted of a felony. If you have answered "YES" please follow the instruction on this link. If your answer is "NO" there is no reason to complete this section.

FCC Qualification Question (arrl.org)

STEP

Take your TEST. Insure you have contacted AECI via the link provided and let them know you are ready. A check will need to be written to ARRL VEC for \$15. Also, should you pass your test, the GENERAL test can also be given at no extra cost.
