This is a directed net and all communications should go through net control.

Please start by saying your call-sign, your name and where you are from.

Let's take a standby for any Emergency or Priority traffic, that's traffic with a number. If so, please call now. {Short pause}

Do we have any routine traffic? If so, please call now. {Short Pause}

Do we have any announcements for the net tonight? {Short pause}

Do we have any Echolink or Allstar stations? {Long pause also listen for Echolink beep}

We will now take check-ins for short timers, low power and those that are for the count only. {Pause} {After first round, ask one more time}

We will now take regular check-ins. {long pause} {Offer regular check-ins several times until there are no more.}

Thank you everyone for checking in to Audrain Emergency Communications Training Net and I hope that you can join us again next week.

I am now going to turn the repeater back over for normal use.
