Your net control tonight is {YOUR CALLSIGN} (Spell it out using ITU phonetics) and my name is {Your Name}.

This is a directed net and all communications should go through net control.

Please start by saying your call-sign, your name and where you are from.

Let's take a standby for any Emergency or Priority traffic, that's traffic with a number. If so, please call now. {Short pause}

Do we have any routine traffic? If so, please call now. {Short Pause}

Do we have any announcements for the net tonight? {Short pause}

~~Do we have any or Allstar stations? {Long pause also listen for Alstar beep}~~

We will take 3 check in's tonight. (read all at once)

1. Short timers, low power (I will ask for comments)
2. Count only.
3. Regular check in with comments

When checking in, Please say your call phonetically, your name and your location.

We will now take check in for short timers, low power only (Don't forget their comments)

We will now take check-ins for and those that are for the count only.

We will now take regular check-ins. (Don't forget their comments)

Thank you everyone for checking in to Audrain Emergency Communications Training Net and I hope that you can join us again next week.

I am now going to turn the repeater back over for normal use.
